

Parcours géocaching « A la Découverte du Patrimoine d'Amirat »

How to play:

Geocaching is an outdoor recreational activity in which participants use a Global Positioning System (GPS).

Geocaching makes it possible to visit places thanks to North and East Coordinates.

The Google Maps application is one of the tools that allow visitors to advance on a course by integrating the provided North and East coordinates. And discover the course more often by solving riddles.

The visitor will be able to observe the various heritages which he will progressively discover.

The course often ends by the search and the discovery of a small waterproof and resistant container, including a register of visits named "logbook" and sometimes one or more "treasures".....

Entering North and East Coordinates in Google Maps.

With the Google Maps Application to start your course, you will enter a latitude (North) and a longitude (East) in degrees (°) and minutes ('), in the menu bar " enter your search".

The first coordinates will always be given to you; some riddles will help you to find the following coordinates of the next steps.

For example to enter : **N 43° 52.952 E 006° 48.526**, you must be careful to respect the spaces, the points, the comma, or (if we expressly indicate)

43space52point952commaspace06space48point526

Then start the search. Click on "itinerary" then "start" to start your course.

The practice of geocaching is under the responsibility and common sense of everyone and hiking in nature needs to have the necessary equipment and the usual protections.

Discretion is a basic principle of geocaching practice.

It' your turn:

Stage 1 : allez à N 43° 52.952 E 006° 48.526

The bell is housed in which structure?

- A small bell tower (3)
- a tower (1).

Remember the number corresponding to the correct answer; it will be used for the final cache

Stage 2 :

Park in the « parking du Pont » at N 43° 53.429 E 006° 49.344, From here, head to be wash basins at N 43° 53.237 E 006° 49.296

Stage 3 :

A magnificent view is waiting for you....

- Amirat means Lookout post (admire) N43 53.367 E006 49.359

- The mountain which the village is backed on N 43 53.327 E006 49.343 ?

Stage 4 :

On the way, find « Estelle », note the last two number corresponding to the address

When You have arrived at this point, which century corresponds to this building ?

-XVIème N43 53.435 E006 49.625

-XVIIIème N 43 53.422 E 006 49.590

Etape 5 :

To join the next stage, a few meters from « Parking du Pont », follow the GR situated on your right at N 43 53.398 E006 49.390.

At number 55, a compass may be useful.

What is the name of the mountain at 160°SE ?

- L'arpille N43 53.417 E006 49.572

-Le Cheiron N 43 53.397 E 006 49.578

Etape 6 :

The numbers of basins will give you the last number necessary to post your log.



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
