Geocaching Course: "Discovery of the heritage of PRIGNOLET and of LA SAGNE"

# How to play:

Geocaching is an outdoor recreational activity in which participants use a Global Positioning System (GPS).

Geocaching makes it possible to visit places thanks to North and East Coordinates.

The Google Maps application is one of the tools that allow visitors to advance on a course by integrating the provided North and East coordinates. And discover the course more often by solving riddles.

The visitor will be able to observe the various heritages which he will progressively discover.

The course often ends by the search and the discovery of a small waterproof and resistant container, including a register of visits named "logbook" and sometimes one or more "treasures".....

## Entering North and East Coordinates in Google Maps.

With the Google Maps Application to start your course, you will enter a latitude (North) and a longitude (East) in degrees (°) and minutes ('), in the menu bar " *enter your search*".

The first coordinates will always be given to you; some riddles will help you to find the following coordinates of the next steps.

For example to enter :  $\frac{N}{43} \frac{52.047}{52.047} \frac{E006}{2.660}$ , you must be careful to respect the spaces, the points, the comma, or (if we expressly indicate)

43space52point047commaspace06space42point660

Then start the search. Click on "itinerary" then "start" to start your course.

The practice of geocaching is under the responsability and common sens of everyone and hiking in nature needs to have the necessary equipement and the usual protections.

Discretion is a basic principle of geocaching practice.

## It's your turn :

Car park : N 43 52.047 E006 42.660

#### Stage 1: go to N 43 52.047 E006 42.660

2 romans, one with a sword, the other carrying the sables of law, will provide you a date. Add each of the numbers and integrate them into the coordinates N 43 52.045 E006 42.6 $\mathbf{X}$  to go to the next step.

#### Stage 2

This building will reveal another date: if you have good eyesight, you will be able to continue your way to : N 43 52.041 E006 42.(**X-1269**)

#### Stage 3

What can you see? a- a hummingbird N43 52.037 E006 42.599 b- a boar N43 52.046 E006 42.600 The correct answer will give you the coordinates to follow.

#### Stage 4

Water is present in one tank (1) or in two tanks (2) Remember the number linked to the correct answer, it will be used for the final cache.

## Stage 5

Get back in the car and drive to N 43 52.688 E006 41.892 So either it.... yellow (5) or brown (6) ? Remember the number linked to the correct answer, it will be used for the final cache.

## Stage 6

Go to N43 52.800 E006 41.475; What kind of material is the statue made of ? a- bronze N43 52.869 E006 41.383

b- wood N43 52.846 E006 41.422

## Stage 7

Water gusches from 3 dragon head (3) or from 4 dragon heads (4) Remember the number linked to the correct answer, it will be used for the final cache.

## Stage 8

Go to N43 52.856 E006 41.325 You arrive in front of a Gallo-Roman funeral cipp. Bottom left, read and note the Roman numeral. Multiply it by 3, then integrate the number into the coordinates N43 52.844 E006 41.4X

## Stage 9

Use your key figures to post your log.
